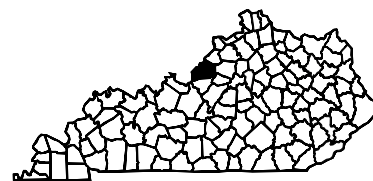

Application deadlines: December 15 for mentored and competitive scholarships, Honors Program and guaranteed entrance programs; May 1 for freshman general admission

Application for admission: \$25 (Nonrefundable; applied to tuition) none if approved for fee waiver
Enrollment deposit: \$100 (Nonrefundable; applied to tuition)
Housing application fee: \$100; \$50 if approved for fee waiver
